

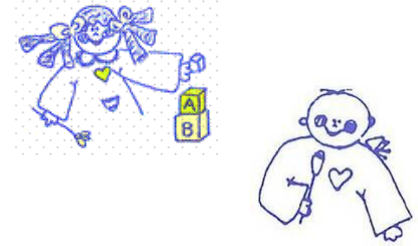

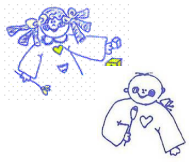

Annual Themes

July 2011 (2 week themes)

“Frolicking Food Fun”

Imagine yourself as a pizza? What would you look like? Cold and mushy? We're going to have quite an adventure examining and experimenting with different types of food through cooking, art, stories and music.

“Under the Big Top”

Ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls – come join us for the ‘greatest show on earth,’ featuring attempting feats of strength. We'll showcase animal trainers, balancing acts and acrobats. In addition, we'll be creating fun crafts and put on a preschool circus featuring our own students.

August 2011 (2 week themes)

“Investigation Station”

Attention science wizards! During the next few weeks, we'll be investigating chemistry secrets, proving that the invisible exists, growing our own crystals and performing light magic!

“The Storyteller”

Creative dramatics, imaginative stories and fun are all a part of this theme! The children will be hearing stories from Hans Christian Andersen as well as other famous authors and constructing costumes and props to go with them.

September 2011

“Caring, Sharing and Getting Along”

We all need each other! Children will be learning techniques on how to relate to one another through verbal and non-verbal communication, random acts of kindness and games.

October 2011

“Let's Play Safe!”

At home, at school, or in our neighborhoods, it's important to play safe! This month, we will examine all aspects of our lives and how we can make it safe. We'll meet people who help us stay healthy and keep us safe.

November 2011

“Harvest Time is Here!”

Fall is the time when farmers harvest their crops. We will learn how farmers cultivate the land, plant the seed and harvest their crops. We will also learn about farming equipment.

December 2011

“Surprise Packages”

We all get excited when we receive a package in the mail or on a special day. Teachers will introduce different items that could come in packages and children will get to explore the possibilities!

January 2012

“Animal Hibernation”

Many animals sleep for long periods of time, especially during the winter months. Why do they do it? We'll find out which animals these are, what happens to them when they are sleeping and when they wake up! We'll also have our own hibernation days at school! February 2012

“My Senses Tell Me...”

Children are sense-oriented. Their world revolves around them! This month we'll test our senses through “How Does It Taste?” collages, “Scent” diaries and “Feeling Feet” paintings! We will also learn how the animal world use their senses.

March 2012

“Jump Into Spring!”

Spring is in the air! Flowers are blooming, snow is melting, and babies are being born. We'll discover life cycles of a butterfly, a chicken and a frog. We'll even have frog jumping contests.

April 2012

“Remarkable Reptiles”

Snakes, lizards, even dinosaurs! Did you know that reptiles need to re-charge their bodies with the sun? We're going to learn why and how. They are cold-blooded-in order for them to move around, they have to warm up. Children will discover the reptiles' eating habits, habitats and characteristics through hands-on investigation.

May 2012

“Viva, Mexico!”

Off we go to Mexico-Arriba! Our imaginary trip will take us to Mexico. We will pack our bags, design an airplane, make passports and take off! Mexico is full of rich culture. We will discover the different regions of the country, taste the food and experience the excitement through music, art and games.

June 2012

“Time for Travelin’”

On a ship, in a plane, in a car, on a train! How and where would you like to travel? We will discover some fun ways and places to explore.
